**Lesson 1 (English Language)**

Noun and its Kinds

A noun is a naming word. It names a person, place, animal or thing in a sentence. There are three different kinds of Noun.

**Kinds of Noun**

1. **Common Noun** :- Names that are used to name all things or person of one kind. E.g. Boy, dog, city etc. A common noun may be singular or plural.
2. **Proper Noun** :- It is used to name a particular person, place or thing. Its first letter is written in capital both in the beginning and in the middle of sentence. E.g. India, Ganga, Asia etc.
3. **Material Noun**:- It is used to name things (Non Living) like material, substance or ingredient for making things. E.g. sugar, mud, milk etc.

### Pronoun and its kinds

A pronoun is noun replacing word. In a sentence pronoun is used to avoid the repetition of noun.

### Kinds of Pronoun

1. **Personal Pronoun** :- It refers to the following three persons.

1<sup>st</sup> Person or Speaker : I, We

2<sup>nd</sup> Person or Listener : You

3<sup>rd</sup> Person or the person spoken about : He, She, It, They

2. **Possessive Pronoun** :- It shows possession or sense of belonging of the pronoun in the sentence.

E.g. This book is mine.

3. **Demonstrative Pronoun** :- It points out or demonstrates the position of person's or things.

E.g. This is my diary.

That is their car
